Legislative Update January 2016 Claudia Pohl

As previously noted, AB 179 was signed by the governor in October and went into effect in January. The RDA Practical Exam is addressed in this bill; it was originally addressed in AB 178, but the efforts of opponents of AB178 resulted in language related to the practical exam being removed. As a result, the choice for continuing or discontinuing the Exam now rests in the hands of the Dental Board, who is completing its Occupational Analysis. The RDA Practical will continue unless the Dental Board between now and July 1, 2017 votes to suspend it once the Occupational Analysis is complete.

Other things that will be affected by AB 179 include an increase in application and renewal fees for the RDA and the OA and DSA permits as well as CE provider fees and new RDA Program or new course fees; the Board was to decide on the fees at the December meeting, but did not. It also now includes term limits (2) for the Dental Assisting Council.

The Occupational Analysis for the RDA is underway. The intent of the Analysis is to learn what licensees are doing and then link the test content and the job duties. As per the Board, they anticipate having results in March/April. When it is complete, the Written Exam will be reviewed and revised as needed. The Practical Exam will also be evaluated and either eliminated or revised.

The CDAA Board has reached out to the Dental Assisting Council to have dialogue, but we have been unsuccessful thus far at having anyone join us.
